We have returned to digital and print in 2022. Digital uploads are due in by 11:59pm on Saturday 23rd July 2022. Print uploads are due in by 11:59pm on Saturday 6th August 2022.

Our Set Subject for August is **Scapes**. This could include landscapes, waterscapes or cityscapes. Whichever you choose it needs to be a broad vista of your chosen scape. People can be in the image but must not be dominant.

We also have our other usual categories of "Open Colour" & "Open Mono".

Judge for August is Bill Chambers.

Currently a member of Belmont 16s Photography Club. Have served two terms as Vice Pres., now a Committee Member.

Initiated, and ran the Training Program for the 16s Club – work had interfered with this, so others have taken on that role.

Have been a qualified Judge since 2004. Now runs Photography Judge Training Courses for Belmont 16s Photography Club. Selected as an International Judge for the Inaugural Lake Macquarie International Circuit 2020.

Main interest is Nature Photography, specialising in Underwater Photography, (beginning in 1975), which I have also taught on a professional basis. Having started a new Hunter Club for Underwater Photography (known as "Snappers") and after seven terms as President, he has recently relinquished that role. Snappers now boasts over 40 active members.

As we all know, when a digital competition is published, we receive an auto-generated email detailing the award given, points scored and the Judge's comments. The comments are often very useful to help us improve our images.

Our judge for June 2022, Ian Marriner, pointed out that as well as learning from the judges' comments on our own images, we can also all learn by reviewing the comments on other people's images too.

The Judge's comments can be viewed on individual photos by clicking MEMBERS Button to get the Members Page and then click a published digital competition to display the entries. Clicking on an entry opens another page showing the image, the judge's comments, and a comments box where you can add a further comment or congratulations, if you wish to do so. From this page you can cycle through all the entries.
