We also have our other usual categories of "Open Colour" & "Open Mono".

Judge for March is Roy Killen.

Roy is well known to us having judged many times for our club.

Roy is an amateur photographer who lives in Newcastle. His main (but not exclusive) interest is in nature photography. Roy is a member of the Belmont 16s Photography Club. He regularly competes in international competitions and has received more than 6400 acceptances and more than 450 awards. Through these competitions he has gained the following honours:

Roy regularly judges competitions at club, national and international levels. He regularly presents workshops for photography clubs on most aspects of photography and image processing.





From this page you can cycle through all the entries.
