The upload deadlines have been adjusted. Digital uploads are due in by 11:59pm on Saturday 20th May 2023. Print uploads are due in by 11:59pm on Saturday 3rd June 2023.

The rules are the same as last year. Enter up to 3 images each month. We have returned to digital and print competitions in 2023.

June Set Subject: - Minimalism - Minimalism is about avoiding the unnecessary; it's about simplicity. It's about less is more.

We also have our other usual categories of "Open Colour" & "Open Mono".

Judge for June is Bill Chambers.

Portfolio Interest Group and Photo Help Group

The idea is to all choose your own theme and provide a brief statement of intent. (This is basically what your images are depicting; the story they tell). Choose 4-10 images that follow that theme. Create a final image which is a collage of the images presented as a summary with images arranged to create one cover image.

The group's meetings are to help critique each other's images and help with ideas on the best images to use once a theme and intent is known. We will have till October to complete these and can decide to present to the entire club or not. Members will get help with editing ideas and possibly improve their art.

This night is also for members who would like some ideas and help with some of their own photos. Bring along any image that you would like the group to help you with. Sometimes, different eyes can see things differently and a discussion can help with how you might process or present the image.

As we all know, when a digital competition is published, we receive an auto-generated email detailing the award given, points scored and the Judge's comments. The comments are often very useful to help us improve our images.

Our judge for June 2022, Ian Marriner, pointed out that as well as learning from the judges' comments on our own images, we can also all learn by reviewing the comments on other people's images too.

The Judge's comments can be viewed on individual photos by clicking MEMBERS Button to get the Members Page and then click a published digital competition to display the entries. Clicking on an entry opens another page showing the image, the judge's comments, and a comments box where you can add a further comment or congratulations, if you wish to do so. From this page you can cycle through all the entries.
