Enter up to 3 images each month. We have both digital and print competitions in 2023.

October Set Subject: - **Mobile Phone Photography**. Only criteria are that the images must be taken with a phone. It can be edited in your software of choice.

We also have our other usual categories of "Open Colour" & "Open Mono".

Judge for October is David Spratt.

David is a Life Member and currently the Senior Vice President of The Entrance Camera Club Inc. David joined in Nov. 1976 coming up for 45yrs, most of those have been spent actively serving on the Committee including 13 years as President.

David had an interest in photography from his early teens and then carried his hobby into his working life. From 1978, David spent 9 years as a professional photographer operating a photographic retail business in Long Jetty including photographing weddings and then for the following 25yrs until he retired in 2012 working from home specialising in Black & White processing and printing including work for the local history section, Gosford Library.

David has seen the Evolution of Photography from Film to Digital, from the Wet Darkroom to the Inkjet Printer with Slides making way for Digital Imaging.

David enjoys a wide variety of photographic interest including People, Nature & Motorsport.

David has been a successful exhibitor in Club, National & International competitions and has judged for Camera Clubs, as well as National competitions including 2yrs on the judging panel for "Black & White Prints" Photography section of the R.A.S Sydney Royal Easter Show.

David has been inducted onto the FCC Roll of Honour from the Federation of Camera Clubs and also awarded the LAPS for photographic skill and the SSAPS for outstanding state service from the Australian Photographic Society.

#### Photographic Society of America (PSA) Interclub Competitions

The Wangi Camera club is a club member of PSA with the specific purpose of entering the international interclub competitions run by PSA during the year.

Competitions are on-going. We are now starting a new year with the PSA Interclub.

The competition buttons are now open under the Members Tab. I have decided to start with a clean slate this time and have deleted all previous entries by everybody so as of now there are no images in any of these files. The new competition entries close at **midnight on Nov 1st**.

The only images which cannot be re-entered are those which have been previously entered. I have put a link in my website post of 19<sup>th</sup> May, to the Master Spreadsheet which has all club images used since we started so you can easily see which of your images have been used.

PSA also requires a signed Release from every member who has an image entered in the competition. Releases are valid for three years and many of the ones I have on file are expiring so I will require a new Release Form from ALL members. There is a link in my website post of 19<sup>th</sup> May, to a Word doc which can be printed and signed. You can then either scan or take a photo with your phone and send to me. ian@bbsol.com or 0411136571. I shall also bring a group form to the next few meetings which you can fill out on the night.

Remember you can upload up to three images in each of the five sections. In the last three rounds, PSA changed from Open and Creative to Open Colour and Open Mono. Any image which was enter in Creative before can now be entered in either. Those entered in Open before can now also be entered in Open Mono but not Open Colour.

Let's aim for some higher finishes this year so looking forward to seeing your best images plus any new images recently created.

Clicking on an entry opens another page showing the image, the judge's comments, and a comments box where you can add a further comment or congratulations, if you wish to do so. From this page you can cycle through all the entries.
