#### MARCH COMPETITON NIGHT

Competition night for March is to be held on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2024 in the Auditorium of the Wangi Workers Club. Digital uploads are due in by 11:59pm on Saturday 25th February 2024. Print uploads are due in by 11:59pm on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Enter up to 3 images each month across both digital and print competitions.

March Set Subject: - Nature. Any Nature Photo that conforms to the "Nature" guidelines detailed on our website in the competition rules section.

We also have our other usual categories of "Open Colour" & "Open Mono".

Judge for March is Roy Killen.

Roy is well known to us having judged many times for our club.

Roy is an amateur photographer who lives in Newcastle. His main (but not exclusive) interest is in nature photography. Roy is a member of the Belmont 16s Photography Club. He regularly competes in international competitions and has received more than 6400 acceptances and more than 450 awards. Through these competitions he has gained the following honours:

- EFIAP (Excellence award, International Federation of Photographic Arts)
- GMPSA (Grand Masters award, Photographic Society of America)
- GMAPS (Grand Masters award, Australian Photographic Society)
- APSEM (Australian Photographic Society Exhibitors Medal)

In 2015 he was awarded the Nature Medallion by the Australian Photographic Society.

Roy regularly judges competitions at club, national and international levels. He regularly presents workshops for photography clubs on most aspects of photography and image processing.

Roy is the Membership Vice President of the Photographic Society of America (PSA).

As we all know, when a digital competition is published, we receive an auto-generated email detailing the award given, points scored and the Judge's comments. The comments are often very useful to help us improve our images.

Our judge for June 2022, Ian Marriner, pointed out that as well as learning from the judges' comments on our own images, we can also all learn by reviewing the comments on other people's images too.

The Judge's comments can be viewed on individual photos by clicking MEMBERS Button to get the Members Page and then click a published digital competition to display the entries. Clicking on an entry opens another page showing the image, the judge's comments, and a comments box where you can add a further comment or congratulations, if you wish to do so. From this page you can cycle through all the entries.

The competition night was held Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2024, in the Wangi Workers Club. The judge for this month's competition was Nicole Curtis.


