Enter a maximum number of 3 images a month, with **no more than 2 images per category**, e.g. if you have entered 2 digital entries in Open Colour Digital competition then you cannot entry a print in Open Colour Print competition.

The competition night was held Monday 11th March 2024, in the Wangi Workers Club. The judge for this month's competition was Roy Killen. A new system was trialled with Digital comments and awards being made on the night. It seemed to work very well, but some modifications may occur.

There were 66 Advanced Grade, 40 A Grade and 18 Open Grade entries over 3 digital and 3 print image categories. There was a total of 124 images entered in the February competition.
