

# A note from our President



Dear Members,

The 2024 NSW TopShot Competition was one of our largest competitions in recent years, and as you will see in this edition of F-Stop, the quality of many winning and runner-up photos was of a very high standard.

Maria Mazo, who has been producing high quality nature and creative photographs for several years now, won the coveted NSW Top Shot award for 2024 and prizes including a new Nikon Z7II valued at over \$4000. Maria received her award at the TopShot exhibition in front of more than 80 people online and at this year's venue, the Mosman Club.

I would like to thank Nikon, Sony and the other sponsors for their continued support of these prestigious NSW photography awards.

As successful as they were, this year, the 70th anniversary of the founding of the FCC, is a good time to evaluate what TopShot has done in the past and if it still meets the needs of our members in the future. Member Clubs have said they want to see the FCC run competitions that will interest their current members and appeal to new members. They want photographs on one subject to be judged fairly against similar photographs, rather than be thrown in with many different types of photography into an "Open" category. And they want some new photographic subjects that have become popular in Clubs in recent years to be recognised in FCC competitions. This is why the new FCC Committee will consider modernising the TopShot competition categories at its meeting in July. We will then let all Clubs know of any changes well in advance so you have time to prepare for future FCC comps.

As well as meeting our members' interests, it is timely to update TopShot and the Interclub competition for another reason:

Today anyone can go on line and produce AI-generated images or deepfake content by using software that mashes together millions of images stored on databases. These algorithms combine multiple photographs to generate an image, but this is not photography. Real photographers, on the other hand, our members, create unique images of their families, their communities and their environment. They create photographs that tell stories, evoke emotions and communicate ideas about our lives and about life in Australia. This is something AI-generated images can never do.

The FCC was formed 70 years ago to support and inspire the creativity, imagination and photographic skills of our members and the photography community of NSW more generally. I'm expecting the new changes to the TopShot and Interclub competitions will do this even better in the future.




